The DPD of the Project discussed about the background of invited bid. Then 3 animation videos of the proposed building were presented through Presentation Screen in the meeting. After the presentation Procurement Specialist of the project started to discuss on the major issues of the requirements of the bids, eligible and qualifications criteria. Section III and VI of the Bid Documents elaborately discussed, Fraud \& Corruption issues was also discussed and made the bidders awareness. Then the floor was opened to receive questions from the bidders.
